### SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

**Description:**

The Calvin Fletcher Scholarship is established in memory of Calvin Fletcher (1882-1963), Art Department Head during the early days of Utah State Agricultural College, later Utah State University. Calvin Fletcher will be remembered for his years of service to and innovation to the Utah State University Art Department, to the Utah art scene, and as a representative on the national art scene. He was a member of national and local arts associations, served in various official capacities, won numerous local awards, and exhibited nationally. However, his most important contribution to Utah art is probably his public support for “modern forms of art interpretation.” During his tenure at Utah State, Fletcher created an “artists-in-residence” program.

**Award Amount:**

Award of \$2,000- \$2,500 for freshmen year only.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Recipients of awards from this fund shall be known as the Calvin Fletcher Scholars.
2. Recipients shall be incoming freshmen in the Art & Design pre-program with an interest in drawing and painting.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to students in good academic standing with financial need.
4. First preference will be given to incoming freshmen who are Cache Valley residents.
5. Recipients will be asked to write a thank you letter to the donor and attend special functions for the college to honor the donor.
6. At the conclusion of their freshmen year, scholarship recipients must submit a digital image of a drawing or painting, which will be sent to the scholarship donor and may be displayed on a website featuring the work of the Calvin Fletcher Scholars.
7. Applicants must complete a current FAFSA (through fafsa.gov) and share it with the USU Office of Financial Aid.
