

BFA Portfolio Review

Students must sign up in the ceramics studio prior to review

Requirements

- A completed application form, available in the Art Office (FAV 122)
- A portfolio of 10-20 pieces (images or actual work)
- Current unofficial transcript

General Expectations

Students applying for the BFA ceramics program are expected to demonstrate outstanding creativity via portfolio, which will also be used to examine the applicant's ability to develop and execute the conceptual use of the medium with respect to the contemporary issues in art. During the Portfolio Review, students must also demonstrate verbal competency in discussing their work with the reviewers.

Review Date

Two weeks prior to priority registration each semester
